This letter will serve as Oswego Community Unit District No. 308's response to your request dated October 9, 2014, and received in our office on October 10, 2014, under the Freedom of Information Act (5ILCS 140/1 et seq.), in which you asked for the above referenced information. Per my communication on October 20, 2014 the District extended the deadline for responding by an additional five (5) business days in accordance with Section 3(e) of the Freedom of Information Act. The responsive documents are attached.

Portions of the responsive record have been redacted pursuant to section 7(1)(g) of the Freedom of Information Act as information that has been furnished under a claim that they are proprietary, privileged or confidential, and that disclosure of trade secrets or commercial or financial information would cause competitive harm to the person or business. Where made redactions have been identified.

You may ask the Illinois Attorney General's Public Access Counselor (PAC) to review this decision concerning your records request, by submitting a Request for Review to the PAC by electronic mail or U.S. mail after this partial denial of your request. You also have the right to administrative review by a court of law pursuant to Section 11 of FOIA.
