# What Does An EMS Do?

- **Emergency & Crisis Management Tool** with procedure manuals, documentation, configurable safety settings, and drill/state reporting
- **Anonymous Bully Reporting** with text & email alerts, dedicated response teams, multilingual forms, and analytics
- **First Responder Integration** to district, police, fire, and other groups
- **Reunification** of parents, students, staff, and community members with gps, maps, and location reporting
- **Real Time Accountability** with gps & classroom mapping, student locations, and two-way communication

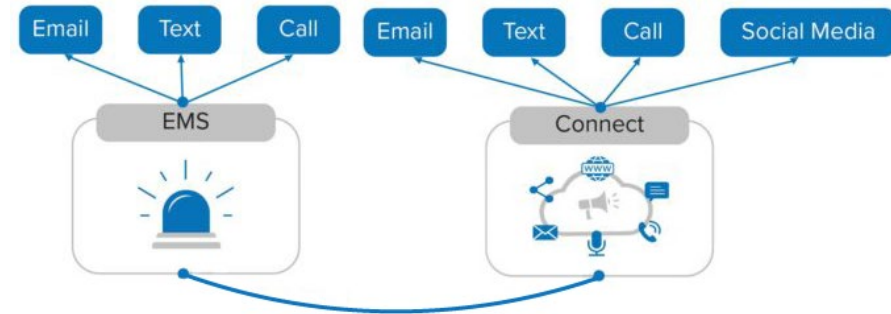
