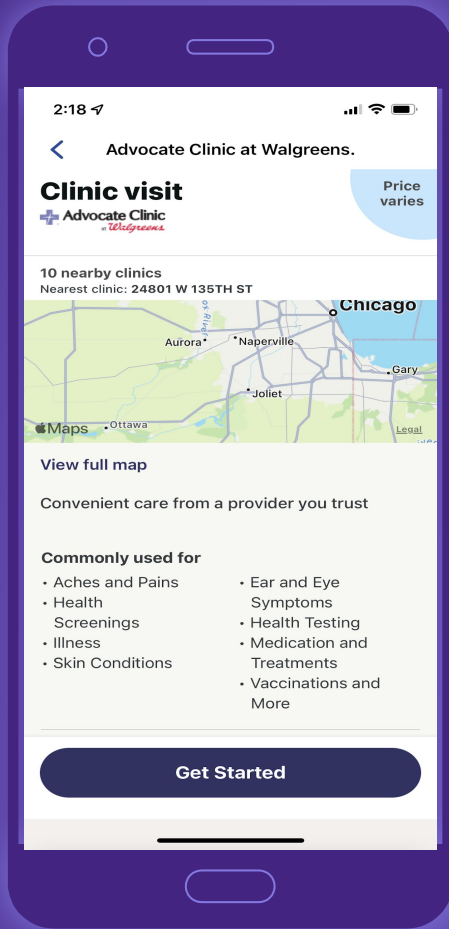
Athletic Season Dates and Sports

	Start Date (some vary)	Sports
Fall	Monday before school starts (typically)	Football, Girls' Volleyball, Golf (Boys and Girls), Girls' Tennis, Cross Country (Boys and Girls), Girls' Swim and Dive, Boys' Soccer, Sideline Cheer, Sideline Dance
Winter	Most start the last week of October/1st or 2nd week of November	Boys' and Girls' Basketball, Boys' and Girls' Bowling, Wrestling, Co-op Gymnastics, Boys' Swim and Dive, Boy's and Girls' Indoor Track (starts in January), Co-op Hockey, Competitive Dance, Competitive Cheer
Spring	Last days of Feb/1st week of March	Baseball, Softball, Girls' Soccer, Boys' Tennis, Boys and Girls' Track, Badminton, Boys' Volleyball, Bass Fishing



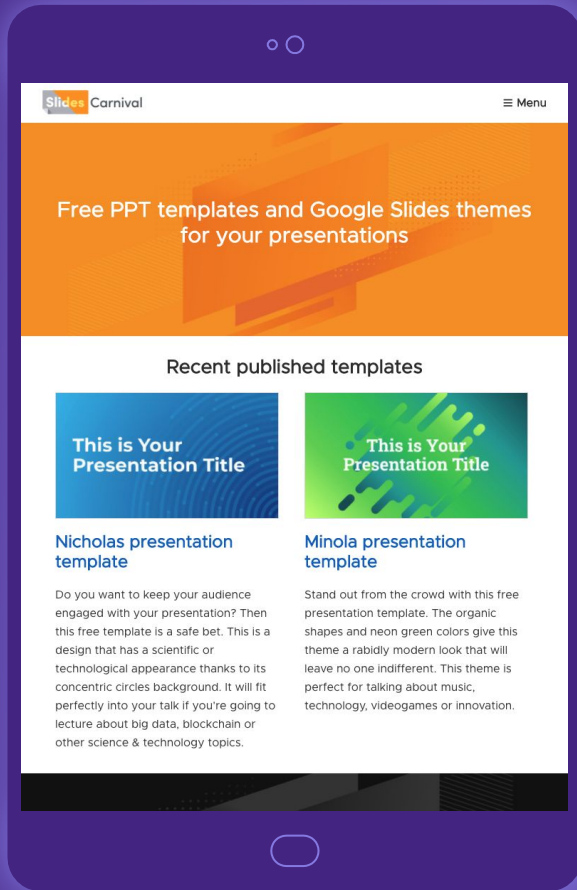
Must be registered in order to try-out
