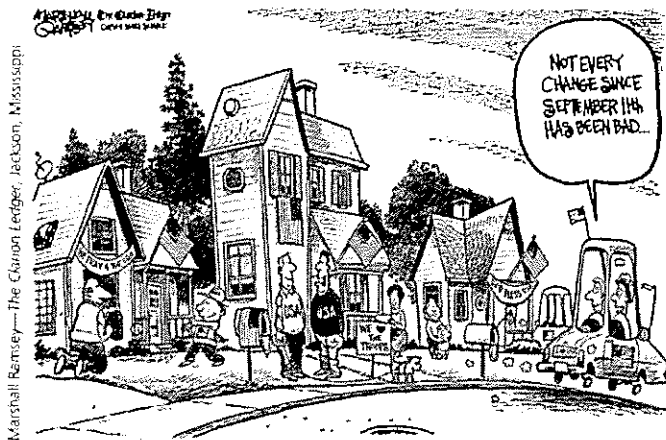


## Political Cartoons in the National and International Press
