## **NURSE'S NOTES**

Here are a few reminders as we move into **2017**:

**Flu season is here!** According to the CDC, the best way to protect against the flu is by getting an annual Flu vaccine. The vaccine helps protect against flu symptoms that can cause missed work and school. For those most vulnerable populations, the vaccine can help prevent flu-related complications which can lead to hospitalizations. Washing your hands frequently with soap and water can help decrease transmission of the flu.

**Welcome New Mustang Families!** SD308 is a sought after district for many families moving into the area. Those families who have recently moved into the district, from out of state, must ensure necessary paperwork is on file with the nurse's office. This includes an Illinois physical, your child's immunization record, a dental exam and an eye exam. Paperwork is required within 30 days of your child's first day of school. Please work with your physician in a timely manner to ensure you meet these requirements and avoid potential exclusion.

**February is Dental Health Month!** Dr. Erika Krouth, from Krouth Dental, will be joining Churchill on Tuesday, February 7, 2017, and visiting with our 1<sup>st</sup> graders to teach them about good oral hygiene. **Required dental exams for second graders** are due by Monday, May 15, 2017. Please mark your calendars, and make your appointments now. \*\*Athena Dental will be returning to Churchill in late Spring. If you are interested in your child seeing Dr. Andrea Miller during her visit, this exam does meet the requirement. Watch future editions of our Churchill Chatter for the upcoming date!

**Lice Notification for Parents!** We have reinstated the notification of lice cases in the classroom. If there is a confirmed case of lice in your child's classroom, a pink notice will be sent home to inform you. We do ask however that you do not wait to receive a notice, but continue to check your child's hair routinely. Being proactive is the best way to avoid an outbreak!



# Notes from the Music Room... . . .

February is Black History Month and also includes Valentine's Day and Presidents' Day which present some great opportunities for musical connections. Some of the grade levels have already begun learning a little bit about jazz musicians Fats Waller and Duke Ellington and their contributions to our American musical culture. We will also make some patriotic music connections to Presidents' Day and sing a Valentine's Day song or two.

Here are the units that each grade level is working on during the month of February:

**First grade:** We are continuing our study of musical opposites with the concepts of loud and soft. Later in the month we will look at long and short sounds and how we use musical notes to represent longer and shorter notes and silences. We will spend at least one music class singing a Valentine's Day song and learning a fun dance.

**Second grade:** This week, we will begin a unit on Patriotic music. We will learn what makes music patriotic and learn several of our most famous patriotic songs and the stories behind them.

**Third grade:** The third graders have begun working on the third grade musical, which they will present on Thursday evening, March 2<sup>nd</sup>, at 7:00 p.m., for their families and friends. This year's musical is entitled "Pirates! The Musical" and promises to be a rollicking good time of singing, acting and dancing by our 3<sup>rd</sup> grade students.

**Fourth grade:** The fourth grade students have begun learning to play the recorders using the book, "Recorder Karate." They earn "belts" by playing songs of increasing difficulty and complexity. They are currently working on basic technique and the first (white belt) song. They will continue this unit for at least the remainder of 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter.

**Fifth grade:** The fifth grade rs are currently learning sixteenth note rhythms and learning to write rhythms correctly in measures according to the time signature. They will be assessed on creating their own rhythms in 2/4, 3/4, and 4/4 time, performing a variety of notated rhythms, and correctly notating teacher-performed rhythms.


