## **School Board Self Governance**

School Board members shall provide self-governance for Board members behaviors that violate any condition or expectations set forth in Board policy.

The act of self-governance shall be provided in a graduated level manner that assumes the Board member's willingness and intention to operate within the stated and implied boundaries of Board policy.

Level 1: Private Notification:

Board member's behavior and violation of policy is made explicit to the Board member involved in a 1-on-1 conversation with the Board President.

Level 2: Public Censure

Board member's behavior and violation of policy is made explicit at a Board work session or in a Public meeting as a matter of a Board Agenda decision item and a resolution of censure is proposed.
