## Complaints About Curriculum, Instructional Materials, and Programs

Parents/guardians have the right to inspect any instructional material used as part of their child's educational curriculum pursuant to School Board policy 7:15, Student and Family Privacy Rights.

Persons who believe that curriculum, instructional materials, or programs violate rights guaranteed by any law or Board policy should file a complaint using Board policy 2:260, Uniform Grievance Procedure Persons with all other suggestions or complaints about curriculum, instructional materials or programs should complete a <u>Curriculum Objection Form</u>. A parent/guardian may request that his/her child be exempt from using a particular instructional material or program by completing a Curriculum Objection Form.
