Student Behavior Expectations

- Walking at all times (no running)
- Phone use is not permitted (but teachers may permit phone use on a case-by-case basis, otherwise phones should be out of sight)
- Food consumption is only permitted in the cafeteria
- Bring your chromebook daily (charged and ready to go!)
- Follow the SD308 acceptable use policy while using your Chromebook

**Student cell phones should be out of sight and silent during the school day. Our procedures for phone violations are:*

- verbal warning from teacher
- second warning = parent phone call
- third warning- student will be asked to bring their phone to the main office where it will be locked up until the end of the school day. Students will retrieve their property at 3:10 PM



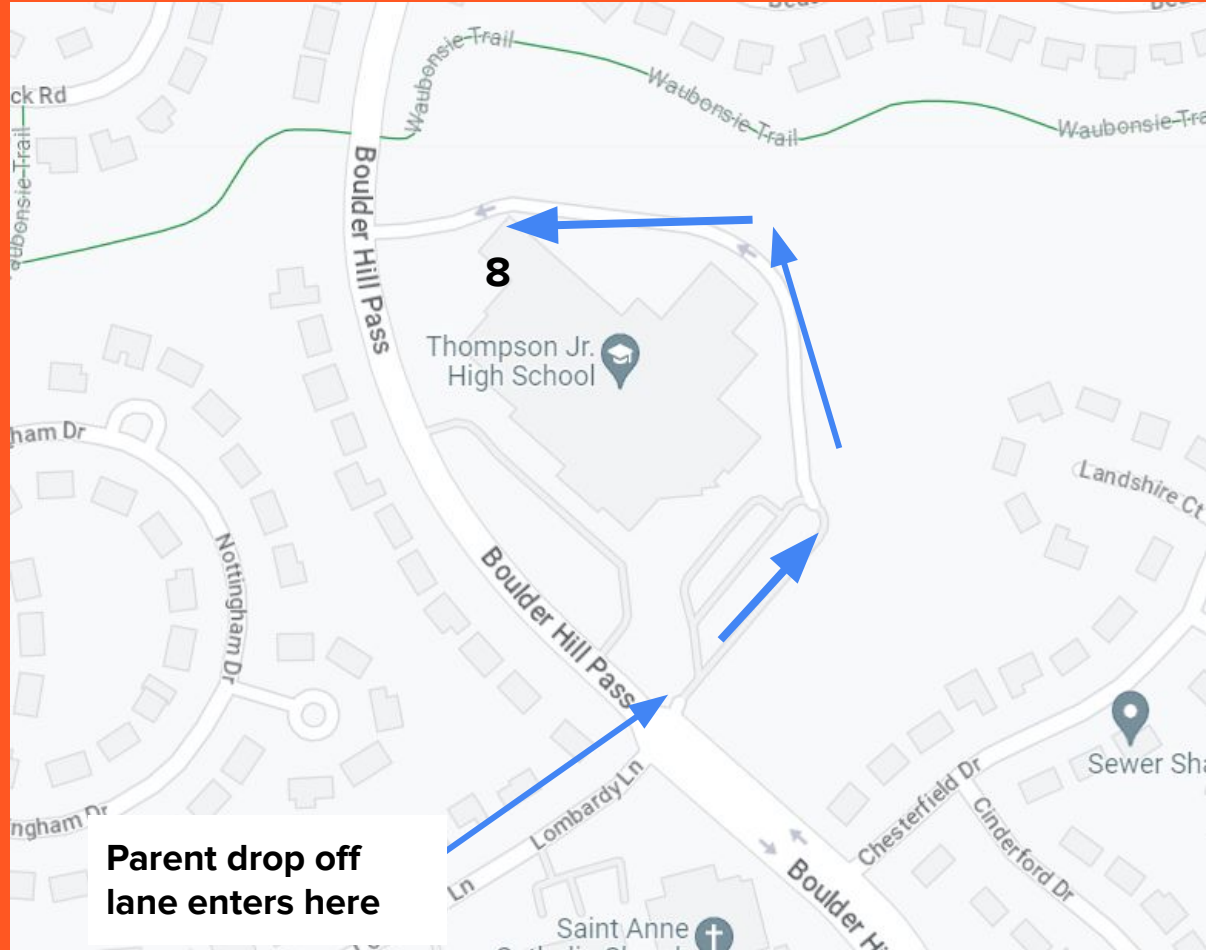
Morning Drop-Off, Walkers, and Bussing

- **School buses are the only vehicles allowed to enter the front driveway to the building in the morning and afternoon. Cars should not enter the front driveway in front of the building (Main Entrance by the flagpole) during arrival and/or dismissal.**
- Buses arrive in this space between 7:30 and 7:45 AM, and remain parked in front of Thompson until the doors open. Late busses often arrive between 7:45 and 8:00 AM, so cars are not allowed in the front of the building during that time window.
- The car drop-off lane enters off the south end of our parking lot and follows the road along the school. Students can be let out of vehicles at Door 8 or when staff directs you to do so. For safety reasons, cars will turn right on to Boulder Hill Pass in the mornings and afternoons.
- Students who walk can enter Door 8 or Door 1 in the morning.

Pass.



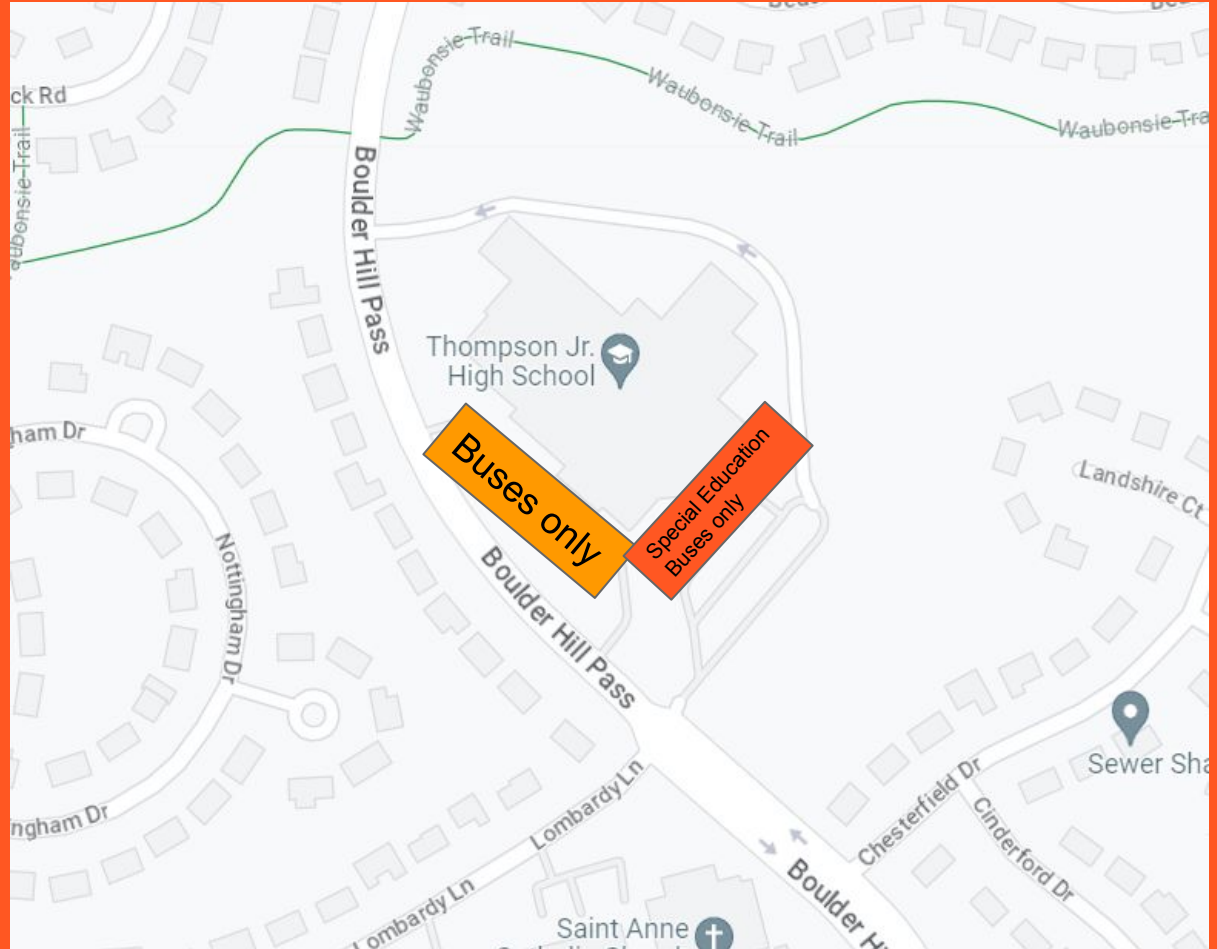
Buses

Between the morning hours of 7:35 to 8:00 AM, school buses are the only vehicles allowed in front of the school.

Between the afternoon hours of 2:40 to 3:10 PM, school buses are the only vehicles allowed in front of the school.

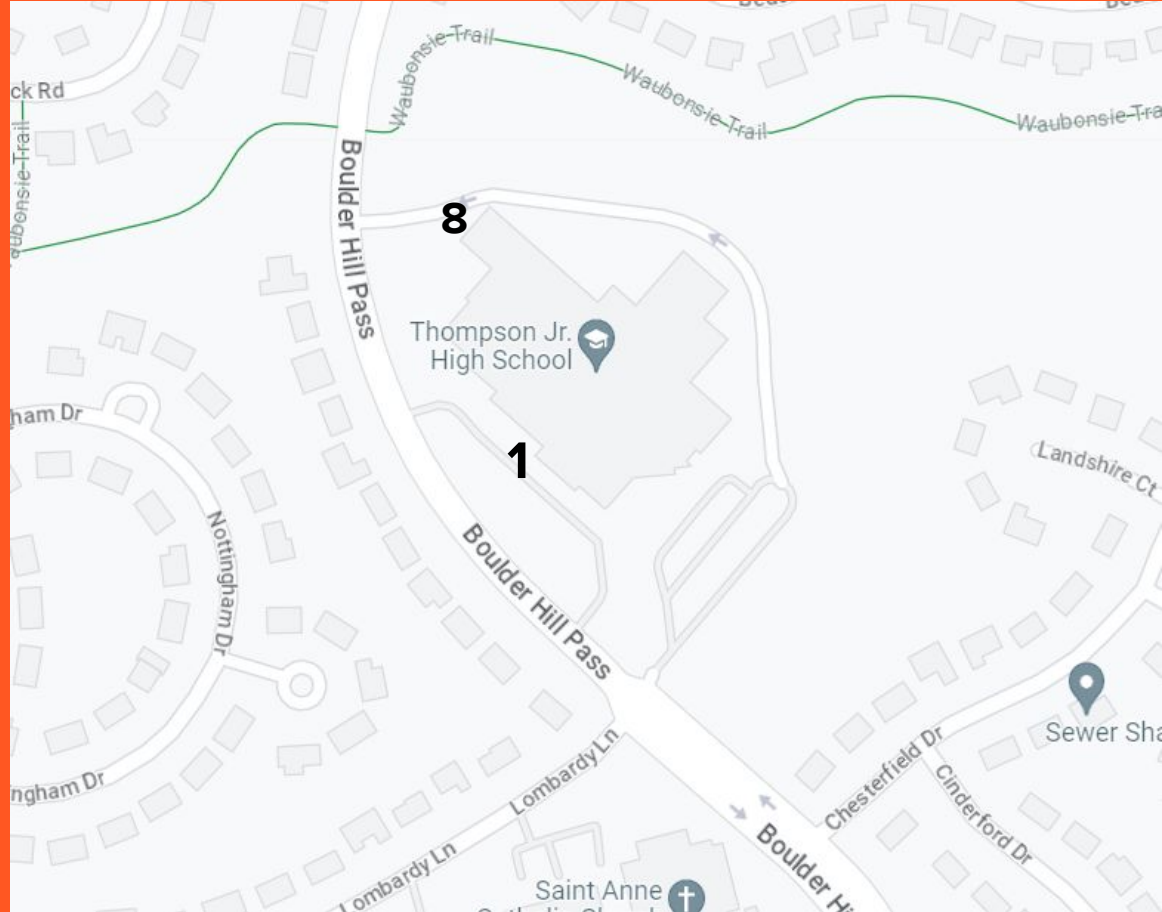
Students taking buses will enter and exit Door 1 in the front of school.

Students taking our Special Education buses will enter and exit Door 14 on the side of the school



Walkers

Students who walk to school can enter Door 8 or Door 1 (the main entrance of school) and should exit the same doors at the end of the school day.
