# HONORS, ELECTIVES, AND INTERVENTIONS

- **Honors** class placement is handled through the district office. If your student has been in a gifted program in elementary, they will likely roll over into Honors ELA and/or Math for Jr. High. - **Electives**: the only elective classes that 6th graders can sign up for are Band or Choir. The other electives are randomly assigned to 6th grade students. The next slide with sample schedules will explain more.

- **Intervention** class placement is based upon data points and 5th grade teacher input to address possible deficit skill areas. Thompson has Intensive Math (2 periods), Intensive Language Arts (2 periods), and Study Dynamics. These are not classes that are available upon request, and may take the place of an elective.

# LOCKERS & PE INFO
