<div>S</div> <div>Stay Safe</div>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Keep your hands, feet and objects to yourself• Report inappropriate behaviors including bullying• Think before you act	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Planner is necessary to leave the classroom• Stay seated until dismissal• Be respectufl of physical space and classroom materials	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Walk on the right side of the hallway• Be aware of others around you and their personal space• Do not assemble in large groups	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Refrain from horseplay• Use lockers and benches the way they are intended• Change, lock up materials and report to class	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Move through lunch line in an orderly fashion• Report and clean up spills• Walk to your table and to the lunch line	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Walk to destinations• Keep aisles clear• Stay on sidewalk until the bus or car comes to a complete stop
