



General Testing Guidelines:

- ACCUPLACER, ACT, SAT, GED and HiSET scores are valid for 3 years from the date of testing. High School English GPA is valid for 3 years from the date of graduation. Visit www.waubonsee.edu/placement for additional expiration terms.
- ACCUPLACER Retests: You may retest **twice** in a 3-year period. The **first retest** is at no charge and test preparation is recommended beforehand. A **second retest** may be taken after waiting at least one week from your most recent test date. Again, test preparation is recommended. There is a \$15 fee per subject test for the second retest.
- ACCUPLACER preparation resources may be found in the Student Portal at www.accuplacer.org
- The higher score on all assessments taken will be used for course placement. See Math Path for specific course titles.

Dual Credit Placement – 22-23 Academic Year

Beginning with the Fall 2021 academic term, Waubonsee Community College now permits multiple measures for placing students into courses/programs intended to be used for dual credit. This set of measures requires verification that students have met one of the following requirements prior to being eligible for registration. Depending on the dual credit arrangement, the student or school will need to electronically submit a valid standardized test score OR a current transcript. **See process below.** All transcripts submitted to the School District Partnership Office (SDP) for verification will remain electronically filed and will not be forwarded or attached to the official WCC student record unless they contain the applicable standardized test score or Transitional course grade. The use of the HS GPA for placement into MTH131 (Calculus I) will “sunset” following the 21-22 academic year.

Dual Credit at your HS – Full Class Registration (or through WCC but arranged by your HS)

- HS electronically submits signed HS Student Authorization Forms to School District Partnerships Office (SDP)
- HS electronically submits test score reports OR transcripts to SDP
- SDP Office forwards documentation to Registration and Records for student registration
*Students using HS GPA for placement will not have transcript officially added to their WCC student record

Dual Credit taken individually through WCC (online or in-person)

- Student completes HS Student Authorization Form
- HS electronically submits test scores or transcripts (if using Transitional course for placement) to Registration and Records
- HS completes and signs Placement Verification Form, if using GPA for placement
- Student brings HS Student Auth Form (and Placement Verification Form if using GPA) to Admissions for registration assistance
