#### November 6, 2020

Open Enrollment NOW through Next Friday, November 13th!! Keep in mind - your current elections will carry over if you don't make a change, with the exception of flexible spending accounts, which do require an active election to continue beyond the end of this plan year. It's easy to enroll:

1) Go to enroll.benefitsconnect.net/cusd; 2) Enter your username and password (username: up to first 6 characters of your last name, first character of your first name, and last 4 digits of your SSN; password: your full SSN without dashes); 3) Follow the prompts to review your existing benefit selections; 4) review your selections, dependent elections, and then click "Finish" to enroll. You will need the date of birth and SSN for each of your dependents (if applicable). These are required to enroll them in eligible benefits and to complete your beneficiary designation. Please review your current elections. You have the opportunity to make changes to the benefits that you are currently enrolled in and also have the option to enroll in additional benefits. Keep in mind - your current elections will carry over if you don't make a change, with the exception of flexible spending accounts, which do require an active election to continue beyond the end of this plan year. # **Employee Daily COVID-19 Self Screening (REQUIRED)**

Please Note: Employees in all buildings/departments (except Transportation, Operations, Oswego and Oswego East High Schools) NO longer are completing the emailed Daily COVID-19 Employee Self-Screening Certification Survey. When entering the building at the start of each day, employees will review the Employee Daily COVID-19 Self Screening statement, which will be posted near building ID scanners, and scan their Employee Identification Card verifying their acknowledgment. At this time, Transportation, Operations, OE, and OH will continue receiving the Daily COVID-19 Employee Self Screening Certification Survey to answer electronically. When the equipment is ready, these locations will move to the new method. For days employees are not in-person at a district site, the guestionnaire is not required.

### Importance of Social Distancing

Please remember the importance of <u>maintaining 6 feet of space or more between individuals</u> whenever possible. Closer encounters should be very limited, totalling no more than 15 minutes over a single day.
