Share A Smile :-)

Open Enrollment ends TODAY!! Current elections will carry over if you don't make a change, with the exception of flexible spending accounts. It's easy to enroll: 1) Go to <u>enroll.benefitsconnect.net/cusd</u>; 2) Enter your username and password (**username:** up to first 6 characters of your last name, first character of your first name, and last 4 digits of your SSN; **password:** your full SSN without dashes); 3) Follow the prompts to review your existing benefit selections; 4) review your selections, dependent elections, and then click "Finish" to enroll.

COVID-19 Information (PLEASE READ)

On Wednesday of this week (November 11), all staff received an email containing a flyer with important "Reminders & Reporting" regarding COVID-19. 1)Daily Self-Certification: When working in an SD 308 building, employees should review posted certification statements and scan ID if true; if statements are false, employees should not remain at the building. This is only required once daily. 2)Face Covering: ALL individuals in school buildings should wear face coverings that cover the mouth and nose, fit snug against the cheeks (not a gaiter/athletic warm-up and no masks with filters). The only time it is safe to remove the covering is briefly when eating or drinking (maintaining 6 feet or more from others) or while alone in a room. For those with approved medical exemptions, additional protections should be put in place. 3)Social Distancing: It is required that all individuals maintain at least 6 feet of space between themselves and others AT ALL TIMES! Encounters closer than 6 feet should be brief (no more than 15 minutes cumulative/daily) and avoided when possible. 4)Reporting: Use COVID Reporting Form (found on district intranet or at www.sd308.org/covidreport) to report any student or staff member who is symptomatic, exposed to a known case, or positive for COVID-19. This is STEP ONE! Designated district health officials will fully investigate the report and notify all close contacts. Health information is private and protected. Together we can help control the spread of COVID-19.
