# **Tier 3 Mitigation Begins Statewide**

The directive states school districts and officials should continue to follow the extensive guidance released by the Illinois State Board of Education in August to make decisions related to in-person and remote learning at the local level.

#### **District Closed**

The district will be closed starting Wednesday, November 25th through Friday, November 27th of next week for Thanksgiving. Please power down any devices that do not need to be on while the district is closed during this time.

# **Delayed Reopening Plan**

The district will be delaying the progression of our reopening plan until at least January 6. Additionally, special education self-contained classes will step back to remote. Related services, instructional support and targeted skills review will be occurring 1:1 on-site. #### **Athletics & Activities On Pause**

In response to mitigation restrictions and announcements from IHSA, changes will be made to the way athletics and activities operate in our district. To allow time for planning and communication, ALL in-person sports, performing arts, extra-curricular activities, and clubs are paused beginning Friday, November 20 through Sunday, November 29. Prior to November 30, guidance regarding the feasibility of resuming these activities and any associated restrictions will be released. Additionally, all rentals for athletic and recreational purposes will be paused until further notice. Thank you for your understanding and patience as we work diligently on a plan that aligns with the newest guidance.

While we unfortunately did not break last year's total, we feel very strongly that this was perhaps one of the most successful drives over the last 7 years considering the constraints imposed due to COVID-19. We thank each and every individual in this district for their support in helping to feed those in need in our community. Over the last 7 years, the district has collected 953,259 total items (next year we will break the 1 million mark)! Congratulations to our Grand Champion - Churchill (23,300 items collected); High School Winner - OHS (16,175 items) and Junior High Winner - Plank (6,327 items). "Hunger hurts.
