Website Accessibility - Alternative text for images, drawing and other graphics

Many documents include images, drawings and other graphics. It is important that these items contain an alternative description; otherwise, screen reader users just hear "image" read to them.

Google Docs:

- Select an image, drawing or graphic
- > Right click > Alt text
- Enter a title and description
- ➤ Click Ok

Word Docs:

- Right click on image, drawing or graphic > Format picture
- > Choose: Layout & Properties option
- Type your alt text in the Description text box

Interesting School Fact

The largest school in the world in terms of number of students is CMS: <u>City Montessori School</u> in Lucknow, India. The school currently has 55,000 registered pupils and 4,500 staff across 18 campuses. They entered the Guinness Book of World Records in 2013 as the largest school, at the time with 39,437 pupils. The school was awarded the 2002 UNESCO Prize for Peace Education.
