FOIA Request

The District's FOIA (Freedom of Information Act) officer received a request for the following information for each district employee: First Name, Middle Name, Last Name, Position, Grade Level (for teachers), Subject Area Taught (for teachers), Certified in the Area of Instruction (for teachers), School Email, Personal Email, Phone, Race/Ethnicity, Hire Date, Years of Experience, and Current Salary. All of this is public information and must be provided **EXCEPT** personal email. The District is required to respond to this FOIA request within 5 business days. In addition, the District is required to notify employees when personal information is requested and supply a copy of documents provided in response to the request.
