SD 308 Wellness Screenings and Flu Clinics

The district is offering five locations over four dates for its annual Flu Shot Clinics and Wellness Screening Events this year. Flu Shots and Wellness Screenings are provided at **No Cost** to all employees and spouses currently enrolled in a SD 308 medical insurance plan who present their SD 308 medical insurance card. A cost of \$32 for Flu Shots and \$91 for Wellness Screenings is charged to all other employees and spouses, which must be paid at the time of service with cash, credit or check.

A message of Safety and Prevention- Heatstroke/Sunstroke and Heat Exhaustion-

Combining heat and humidity with physical activity can result in heat illness. *Heat exhaustion* is less serious than heatstroke, but may lead to heatstroke. While it is important to recognize the symptoms and know the treatment, it is even more important to **prevent** heat related illness. If you work outdoors, follow these tips: (1) Drink extra fluids. (2) Wear lightweight, light-colored clothing, loose-fitting clothing, and a wide-brimmed hat. (3) Use a sunscreen with a sun protection factor (SPF) of 30 or more. (4) Avoid beverages with caffeine and alcohol. (5) If possible, shift your time outdoors to the coolest times of the day, either early morning or after sunset. (6) Take frequent breaks to sit in the shade.
