PRIDE Program

We are excited to share with you the details about this year's PRIDE program! The PRIDE Recognition Program began in the fall of 2015 to recognize, promote and celebrate the many contributions made by teachers, employees and volunteers of Oswego Community Unit School District 308.

Beginning this year, more teachers and employees will be recognized for their great work! And, individual schools and departments will own the process for choosing their PRIDE winners. Depending on the size of the school or department, there may be 1-3 teacher(s) and employee honorees which will recognize a total of 46 teachers and 32 employees this year from ALL schools and ALL areas of the district.

National Board Certified Teacher Cohort

DuPage ROE is proud to announce that they will be a cohort host site for teachers pursuing National Board Certification during the 2019-2020 school year. This cohort will meet 12 times throughout the school year and is led by a trained National Board Certified Teacher who will guide teachers through the process at no cost. Teachers can earn 24 Professional Development clock hours as they complete their National Board components. The state offers a subsidy to pay for all fees associated with becoming a National Board Certified Teacher (there is a one - time \$75 registration fee, which is the only cost a teacher will incur). Professional Development Opportunities

Looking for professional development opportunities? Illinois State University is offering online courses called **onlineIMPACT** that offer 15 to 30 professional development hours towards license renewal for teachers. Their professional learning workshops are led by facilitators with expertise in workshop topics such as math, English language arts, science, data, technology and are specifically trained to teach online workshops to ensure that participants receive a quality educational experience. Each workshop has a maximum of 20 participants, which allows facilitators to easily communicate and work online with all participants together or with individual participants enrolled in their workshops. Workshop time frames are variable and can be completed in five to seven weeks, with participants spending an average of three to four hours a week engaged in workshops and completing assignments.
