DEI Staff Survey

In efforts to gather information to inform the district's equity focused school improvement efforts, the district is engaging in an Equity Context Analysis Process (ECAP) to determine the extent to which educational equity is evident in our school district. Field Trip Instructions

As a reminder, a certain process needs to be followed for field trip requests, below is a list of steps to assist you with correctly completing the district-level request.

- 1. Submit google doc field trip request (found on Intranet)
- 2. Review the "Estimated Costs" of trip that you will receive after google doc has been processed (usually next day)
- 3. Have your building administrator (and SpEd Director if necessary) review and approve field trip request
- 4. Scan and submit approved field trip request to fieldtrips@sd308.org
- 5. Enter trip information into Trip Tracker
- 6. **Wait** until "FINAL APPROVAL" has come back from the district office before proceeding with trip processing
- 7. Submit chaperone list to ckrachtus@sd308.org (at least 5 days prior to trip)
