We Need Your Input! DEI Staff Survey Open Through Nov. 2

Parent and caregiver responses are going well, but we need to hear more from our staff! To gather information to inform the district's equity focused school improvement efforts, the district is engaging in an Equity Context Analysis Process (ECAP) to determine the extent to which educational equity is evident in our school district. The ECAP was designed by the district's equity partners Midwest and Plains Equity Assistance Center (MAP) and involves several data collection activities, including the completion of staff questionnaires, parent/caregivers

questionnaires, and school visits.
