#### **School Designations**

The Illinois State Board of Education (ISBE) released designations for every school in the state. The designations provide a public benchmark of each school's progress toward the goal of preparing all students for success in college and career. The designations were made based on a number of measures of performance. Designations include exemplary, commendable, underperforming and lowest-performing.

Our goal as a district is for all of our students to be successful. The supporting data that we have received from ISBE related to the performance of any student groups not meeting expectations, along with local data, will be used to determine the level and type of targeted assistance we will provide to support any sub-groups under-performing.

While our total student scores exceed state averages in standardized testing, there are pockets of students who are not showing adequate rates of growth. A school with one or more student subgroups (made up of 20 students or more who took a particular assessment) underperforming at or below the "all students" group in the lowest-performing 5% of all schools received an underperforming rating and will receive additional federal funding. In order for a school to be designated as commendable or exemplary, there must be no underperforming student groups at or below the "all students" group in the lowest-performing 5% of all schools.
