New Student Information System

For the 2019-20 school year, we will be implementing a change in our student information system (SIS) from eSchool to Tyler Technologies for all users. Staff will use the Tyler SIS system for all the same functions that we currently go to eSchool for (grades, attendance, discipline, student information, critical alerts, etc.). While the Tyler SIS platform may look a little

different, staff will have access to the same information in a more user-friendly format. Please be assured that no student data will be lost in the transition.
