# **Memorial Day Monday**

The district is closed this coming Monday, May 27 for Memorial Day.

Memorial Day is a federal holiday in the United States, remembering and honoring people who have died while serving in the United States Armed Forces.

In Oswego, the American Legion Post 675 will honor those who have fallen with a Memorial Day Parade beginning at 10am downtown Oswego, going to the Oswego Township Cemetery for a memorial service.

In Montgomery a Memorial Day service will be held at Riverside Cemetery on north River Street at 11am, hosted by the Montgomery chapter of the Veterans of Foreign Wars.

Aurora will host a Memorial Day parade beginning at noon on Monday routing through downtown.
