Our 14th Annual Allied Bank Crosstown Challenge Football Game between Oswego and Oswego East High Schools will be on Friday, October 5th at OEHS, Sophomores play at 4:30pm followed by the Varsity game at 7pm. Ticket prices are \$3.00 per person; NO passes allowed for this contest.

SD 308 staff has the opportunity to purchase two tickets at \$3 each in person ONLY on Monday, October 1st. Staff ID must be presented at the time of purchase. Tickets will be sold at OHS and OEHS from 7am-5pm. Cash and check only (no credit cards). Staff choosing not to purchase tickets on Monday, or those wanting more than two tickets, will need to purchase during the designated general sale times.

Online general ticket sales will be Monday, 10/1 through Thursday, 10/4; tickets will be capped at four per purchase. Each day, beginning at 8am, an allocated number of tickets will be released online. Once sold, ticket sales for that day will close. Tickets will be capped at four per adult purchase, with a limited quantity available at each school; at OHS enter through door 37, at OEHS enter through door 41. Phone System Update

Some of our buildings are on a new phone system. MT, MU, TC, OH, OE and DAC/EVA have switched over to the Avaya phone system. Individuals who are on this phone system are able to direct dial using a 4-digit extension. However, for them to reach any other building, the full 10 digit phone number needs to be dialed. For buildings not on the Avaya system, they can direct dial each other using a 4 digit extension, but will need to dial the full 10 digit number to reach MT, MU, TC, OH, OE and DAC/EVA.
