

(Day of German Unity)



Tag der Deutschen Einheit ([Day of German Unity](#)) is the German national holiday, commemorating the anniversary of German reunification in 1990.

The Day of German Unity is celebrated each year with a **Bürgerfest** hosted by a major city— 2022 geplant in **Erfurt**, Hauptstadt of **Thüringen**.

The Bürgerfest also includes the **Ländermeile**, where each Bundesland can highlight their tourist attractions, cultural treasures, and culinary specialties. This is supported by the [Zipfelbund](#).

DIENSTAG is the 6th National TEACH GERMAN Day. This day celebrates German teaching and learning.

AATG encourages the next Generation of German Teachers. National TEACH GERMAN Day is for sharing the story of language education's importance in the US, and encouraging students to consider careers as German educators.

All advocates of German language education engage in a variety of activities to celebrate and promote German. Come check out what students are doing!

*Celebrates German-American heritage

*Commemorates the [13 German families who moved to Philadelphia from Krefeld](#) in 1683, who founded Germantown, Pennsylvania.

*Germantown was the first German settlement in the original thirteen American colonies.

*Germantown organized the first petition in the English colonies to abolish slavery in 1688.

*1883 was the first celebration of "German Day". This marked the 200th anniversary of the Krefeld settlers.

*During World War I the custom died out until 1983.

*In 1983, President Ronald Reagan proclaimed October 6 as [German-American Day](#) to celebrate and honor the 300th anniversary of German American immigration and culture to the United States.

*In 1987 it became [Public Law 100-104](#)
