Dear AP Students & Parents/Guardians,

Taking Advanced Placement exams is an important part of all AP courses. Oswego East High School recommends that all students take AP exams for the AP classes in which they are enrolled during the 2021-2022 school year. Scoring well on an AP exam can earn students college credit for their high school class, saving a significant amount on tuition. Advanced Placement exams will be administered at Oswego East High School from May 2– May 13, 2022. You can find the schedule for AP exams on the following page of this letter. The cost per AP exam is \$99.00. The cost for the AP Capstone exams (AP Seminar and AP Research) are \$147.00 each. Fee waivers will be provided for income qualified students.

Registration for AP exams through the College Board (Step 1) and Payment through Total Registration (Step 2) will be available from Wednesday, September 1, 2021 at 12:00 AM until Sunday, October 31, 2021 at 11:59 PM.

Registrations that have *not* been paid for in-full through Total Registration will be canceled and exams will *not* be ordered.

Per College Board, any late registrations will incur a late fee of \$40.00 per exam. Thus, late registrations will cost \$139 per AP Exam; AP Capstone Exams (AP Seminar and AP Research) will cost \$187 per exam.

AP Exams can be cancelled with no penalty until **Sunday, October 31st, 2021 at 11:59 PM**. AP Exams cancelled after this date will receive a partial refund, as the College Board charges a \$40 fee for unused exams. While the AP Exams are in the spring, AP Exam registration occurs in the fall. Please be sure to read the following information carefully regarding the registration and payment deadlines and fees.

Students must complete Step 1 AND Step 2 in order for AP Exams to be ordered:

Step 1: Register for AP Exams

- Registration for AP exams through the **College Board** will be available from Wednesday, September 1, 2021 at 12:00 AM until Sunday, October 31, 2021 at 11:59 PM.
- Students log into myap.collegeboard.org.
- Click on “Register for Exam” for *each* class section in which they are enrolled. If they do not see AP courses in their account, they must see their AP teacher for the join code.
- Select “Confirm Registration” if they are choosing to take the AP Exam, OR select “No, I wish to remove myself from taking this exam,” if they are choosing *not* to take the AP Exam.

Step 2: Pay for AP Exams

- Payment for AP exams in **Total Registration** will take place Wednesday, September 1, 2021 at 12:00 AM until Sunday, October 31, 2021 at 11:59 PM.
- Parents/Guardians and students login to user.totalregistration.net/AP/143331 user.totalregistration.net/AP/143330. We strongly recommend that parents *and* students are both present while registering to ensure that the correct exams are ordered.
 - Registrations *not* paid in-full through Total Registration will be canceled and exams will not be ordered.
 - Any late registrations will cost \$139 per AP Exam. AP Capstone Exams (AP Seminar and AP Research) will cost \$187 per exam. This includes a \$40.00 late fee per exam.

 - Additionally, students are not able to leave an exam early for athletics, appointments or any other reason.
- Students MUST have an ID upon check-in.
