

Re: FOIA Request received March 20, 2015 FOIA ID #15-14

Dear Ms. Vickers:

This letter will serve as Community Unit District 308's response to your request under the Freedom of Information Act (5ILCS 140/1 et seq.), which sought documents, emails or communications between the National PTA and/or the Illinois PTA and any of the following District personnel: Dr. Matthew Wendt, Dr. Paul O'Malley, Dr. John Sparlin, Dr. Judith Minor, Kristen Bonie, Dr. Brenda Dixon, Rosemary Gonzalez-Pinnick, Brian Graves, Julie Lam, Jamie Max, Melissa McDowell, Tim Neubert, Valerie Patterson, Mary Redding, Sherry Reynolds-Whitaker, Jeffrey Ryder, Dr. Kellie Sanders, Roxana Sanders, Dr. Lisa Smith, Theresa Ulrich, Eric Watt, or Andrea Wiaduch between July 1, 2013 and today. Attached are the documents responsive to your request.

Certain documents have been withheld because they are exempt from disclosure pursuant to 5 ILCS 140/7(1)(f). The withheld documents are unreleased drafts of documents.

The decision to partially deny your request was made by Victoria R. D'Aleo, Freedom of Information Officer, with the assistance of counsel. Should you believe that this decision was in error, you may ask the Illinois Attorney General's Public Access Counselor (PAC) to review this decision concerning your records request, by submitting a Request for Review to the PAC by electronic mail or U.S. mail after this denial of your request. A Request for Review by the PAC should be directed to Public Access Counselor, Office of the Illinois Attorney General, at 500 S. 2nd Street, Springfield, IL 62706, publicaccess@atg.state.il.us. The PAC's telephone number is (217) 558-0486.

To promote district transparency and assist others who may have a similar question, this responsive document will be posted online on the district's website. Please be advised that to comply with your FOIA request, the District incurred the expense of \$1373.03, comprised of the cost of labor and resources used to search for, retrieve, examine and review records responsive to your request. You are legally not required to reimburse the District for the amount incurred.
