Dear Ms. Freishtat:

This letter will serve as Community Unit School District 308's response to your December 2, 2016 request under the Freedom of Information Act (5 ILCS 140/1 et seq.), in which you asked for the above referenced information. The information responsive to your request is as follows:

- 1) Documents sufficient to show the number of virtual education courses taken for initial credit during each of the following semesters:
 1. fall 2015, - 73 courses taken
 2. spring 2016, - 213 courses taken
 3. summer 2016, - 329 courses
 4. fall 2016 – 70 courses taken
- 2) Documents sufficient to show the number of virtual education courses passed for initial credit during each of the following semesters:
 1. fall 2015, - 65 courses passed (89.4%)
 2. spring 2016, - 185 courses passed (87%)
 3. summer 2016, - 321 courses passed
 4. fall 2016 - data not available within current semester
- 3) Documents sufficient to show the number of students enrolled in virtual education courses for initial credit during each of the following semesters:
 1. fall 2015, - 73 students enrolled
 2. spring 2016, - 210 students enrolled
 3. summer 2016, - 329 students
 4. fall 2016 – 70 students enrolled in 70 courses
- 4) Documents sufficient to show the number of traditional classroom high school courses taken during each of the following semesters:
 1. fall 2015, - 34,270 courses
 2. spring 2016 – 33,5648 courses
 3. summer 2016, - 30 courses
 4. fall 2016 – 34,552 courses

5) Documents sufficient to show the number of traditional classroom high school courses passed during each of the following semesters:

1. fall 2015, - 33,337 courses were passed (97%)
2. spring 2016, - 32,325 courses were passed (97%)
3. summer 2016, - 30 courses were passed (100%)
4. fall 2016 – 32,818 courses were passed (95%) as of midterm final data not available within current semester until December 21, 2016
