- 2) If yes, what is the size (# lanes x length) of the pool(s)? It is 8 lanes wide and 25 yards long.
- 3) Is swimming a required course? Swimming is a required course at OEHS, but not at OHS.
- 4) If yes, how many weeks in the pool and number of rotations (years of swimming) are required? 3 weeks. It is required at the 9<sup>th</sup> grade and 10<sup>th</sup> grade level.
