Hi Mary -

This is what I was able to pull.

1) For this question I am only able to pull data for current year. We don't have any reports in place the pull this information for prior years and the creation of a new report would be needed.

For this current year (as of today) I have a total of 1,524 students that are attending a school within district that is not their home school based on address. I did not include homeless students, and students placed here from other school districts. I also did not count the Brokaw students attending our satellite locations and those students at GOAL.

I am not sure if you received data elsewhere for question 2 but this is what I was able to gather.

2) These counts are for grades k-5 only. I have 17 students fully outplaced outside of our district, and I have 13 outplaced to East View Academy and lastly I have 5 that split between one of our in district gen ed schools and another facility. Here are the facility names that they are placed at but I do not have the addresses available in eSchool.
