For this request, please provide the information in aggregate including (if available): type of device, school that device-assigned student attends, date of issuance, data or report of loss, and any other relevant information. In addition, please provide (if available) documentation showing the total number of remote learning equipment assigned.

Dear Gentlemen:

This letter will serve as Oswego Community Unit School District 308's response to your January 11, 2022 request under the Freedom of Information Act (5 ILCS 140/1 et seq.), in which you asked for the above referenced information.

From 3/15/2020 – 7/31/2020 we distributed 2,903 devices; between 8/1/2020 - 7/31/2021 we distributed 13,155 of which 7,707 were 1:1 devices and 5,448 were devices that were previously in carts, which when purchased were about \$310/each. The 7,707 devices were a new model and specifically purchased for the new 1:1 program and cost about \$260/each.

At this time, inventory status, replacement devices and/or costs data is not available.
