

**1. Number of students in the Dual Language (DL) Program for 2017-2018.**

The total number of students in the Dual Language (DL) Program (grades K-8) is **511**.

**2. Number of students in the program placed there out of parent desire (through the lottery process) not those required the opportunity due to qualifying for services (TPI/TBE).**

The total number of students placed in the Dual Language (DL) Program (grades K-8) out of parent desire (through the lottery process or the sibling rule ) is **218**.

**3. Number of students, listed by home school, who qualify for TPI services.**

The number of students who qualify for TPI services (PreK -12) is **496**.

**4. Number of students, listed by home school, who qualify for TBE/Dual Language services.**

The number of students who qualify for TBE (PreK -12) is **711**.

The number of students who qualify for Dual Language (grades K-8) is **235**.

**5. Number of students, listed by home school, who refused/declined TPI services.**

The number of TPI students (PreK -12) who are refusals/withdrawals is **32**.

**6. Number of students, listed by home school, who refused/declined TBE/Dual Language services.**

The number of TBE students (grades K-8) who are refusals/withdrawals is **28**.

**7. Number of students, listed by home school, who refused TBE/Dual Language services but requested to be placed in the TPI program at the home school.**

The number of students who refused TBE/Dual Language but requested to be placed in the TPI program at the home school is **348**.

**8. Amount of staff FTE for TPI programming allocated to each school listed by school. (See table below.)**

Students who qualify under the TPI Program are serviced through two instructional program models: English as a Second Language (ESL) and Sheltered English Instruction (SEI). ESL and SEI teachers deliver these services. The district's SEI instructional model is housed at Old Post Elementary School. At Murphy Junior High School, two content courses are delivered through SEI.

There are buildings that meet the threshold for TBE programming (20 or more students with the same language background). These buildings are assigned Bilingual Support staff who provide Spanish instructional support and deliver ESL instruction (as

appropriate -based on student needs and teacher caseload). Teachers at Brokaw Early Learning Center have the endorsement to service English learners in their classroom. This is the reason there are buildings with an allocation of “0” as its FTE. The table below outlines the details requested. The asterisk denotes buildings with Bilingual Support staff.
