To get your library card at the Oswego Public Library, bring your Mom, Dad, or guardian to the library.

Make sure your parent/guardian brings:

A photo I.D. with your current address

If your ID does not have your current address, also bring proof of your current address. This can be a utility bill, check book, or driver's license with current address.

Sign up for the internet! *3rd grade and up*

When you get your library card, have your grown up sign you up to use the internet computers too!

Your library card will let you check out materials at the library **AND** use our online resources at home or on the go!

How to Get Your Reciprocal Library Card

If you do not live in Oswego or Montgomery, stop by your home library first! Once you have a library card, come visit us and we will get your card to set up to borrow materials from our library!

Make sure your parent or guardian brings—

Your library card and visit us while your home library is open! We will need to call them and make sure everything is up to date. Your home library card also cannot be blocked for fines or other reasons!

A reciprocal card will not let you place holds or check out e-books at this time.
