Attention 5th Grade Parents. As your child transitions to Junior High, there are new health requirements for the next school year. Forms can be turned in to the nurse's office at The Wheatlands through the end of this school year. After that, forms should be turned in at the Junior High over the summer. Please let us know if you have any questions at **630-636-3502**.

Complete 6th grade Physical Examination and all required immunizations including:

One dose of Tdap Vaccine

One dose of Meningococcal Vaccine (meningitis) after the 11th birthday

Two doses of Varicella Vaccine (chicken pox)

Three doses of Hepatitis B at the required intervals

Complete 6th grade Dental Examination - Must be turned in prior to May 15, 2023.
