Math Proposals

- Calculus III

- Dual Credit through Waubonsee Community College (WCC)
 - 4.0 credits
 - Transferability: IAI course and IAI Major course
- Length: 1 year
- Weighting: Honors
- Prerequisite: AP Calculus BC - “C” or better
- Course Fee: \$70 - Supplemental textbook (*currently \$22*) and WCC dual credit tuition (*currently \$12 per credit hour*)
- Costs: Professional development and curriculum writing hours
