Additionally, there are guidelines that every good map follows.

- ❖ Every map includes: Title, a compass rose, and a key. Other helpful hints: Bodies of water are always labeled in blue. Label all countries and cities in black INK (no pencil please!) Capital cities are marked with a star, regular cities just a dot.

Places of significance: England/U.K., Ireland, France, Italy, Spain, Portugal, London, Russia, Paris, Germany, Berlin, Atlantic Ocean, Finland, Poland, Rome, Greece, Sweden, Mediterranean Sea, Austria, Berlin, Belgium, Moscow, Baltic Sea, The Alps, Norway, North Sea, Denmark, Czech Republic, Turkey, Black Sea, Switzerland.
